Dear Prospective Physician,

As a practicing primary care physician, I can relate to being inundated with the changes our health care system has undergone the past few years. Electronic health records, malpractice, pay for performance incentives and complex insurance negotiations are known culprits in removing the joy of being a physician. Fortunately, I have found an organization where medicine is still practiced the way we have always envisioned it– places where you can practice medicine the way it was meant to be. Family Health Care is a non-profit organization composed of Federally Qualified Health Centers in West, Central, and Northern Michigan. We serve all members of the community including those who are un/under insured by providing basic primary care outpatient services. As a health center, we are fortunate to have colleagues of dentistry, pharmacy and behavioral health work next to us in providing a full complement of health care services to our patients. Before becoming medical director at Family Health Care, I spent several years in both private practice and a hospital owned practice. I understand first-hand the administrative headaches and lack of control physicians experience in those settings. Physicians, like you and I, are longing for the old days where providers were focused on the patient and not the administrative tasks.

I am pleased to say that Family Health Care understands this and works closely with each physician to ensure that patient care is the provider's first priority and that administrative issues are left to administration. At Family Health Care physicians have flexibility in their schedules and are relieved of the administrative duties. In addition to Medical Doctors, Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners are used to enhance the medical services and allow for improved response to patient needs and foster a team atmosphere. Having a strong sense of community and improvement, Family Health Care allows physicians to teach or undertake a collaborative research project in public health while seeing patients. In addition Family Health Care has responded to the electronic health record system by instituting a scribe system to help increase physicians time with the patient and allowing for more meaningful consultations.

The satisfaction derived from knowing you are helping someone improve their health in a significant way is very rewarding within itself., Family Health Care is very competitive in complimenting these satisfactions with a benefit and salary package specifically designed for physicians. Family Health Care stands behind physicians by providing Federal malpractice tort, raising the level of security above standard malpractice coverage.
